OVERVIEW:

This position is for a Team Captain to be responsible for appearance and attractiveness of our various SJ and XC jumps and fences so that FHI consistently presents the very best image.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

This individual will work with the Competition Manager and Grounds Tech to identify which jumps require facelifts. He/she will oversee "scheduling" and painting/staining where needed. A critical prep position, it requires coordinating other volunteer painters, amassing paint and supplies (provided by FHI), attention to detail and deadlines. The work is outdoors on DNR property. The work can be done by individuals or group "painting parties" at whatever day/time works best. It may be co-chaired if you like. How about your significant other?

QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Experience recruiting and directing a small group of volunteers a plus as is any painting/staining experience. It certainly need not be professional experience.
