### Job Description

**OVERVIEW:** Fair Hill International is a non-profit entity producing The Dutta Corp. USEF Fall Eventing Championship, and Young Event Horse East Coast Championships, October 16-20, 2019. This position is for a volunteer coordinator to plan, setup, and oversee activities in the Kids' Corner for all day of Saturday of XC at the October event.

### ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Kids' Corner Chair:

- Will plan and assemble materials for Arts & Craft activities to take place in the Kids' Corner area and tent. Such activities might include, but not be limited to: face painting, stick horse creation, horse shoe painting, coloring of horse-related images, etc.
- Will coordinate with DNR to possibly share space with the park Naturalist who might have child-appropriate nature displays or critters.
- Will coordinate with the Special Events Chair space for possible demonstrations by a fire engine, Sparky, mini-horses, or similar kid-friendly activities.
- Will coordinate set up of props/areas often appearing in the Kids' Area which may include the big corn box (and arranging load of corn), stick horse raceway, barn/farmyard play area, two photo boards. These areas are designed to be parent or kid-self-initiated.
- Recruit a couple helpers (who could be teens).

This program/area is not intended as a baby-sitting program, and kids are expected to make short visits throughout the day. Activities are generally aimed at K-6 grade kids. Children should be accompanied by a supervising adult.
