

25-mile loop with a 10-minute gate and go crew can meet you, 45-minute hold 15-mile loop, 45-minute hold 25-mile loop, 45-minute hold not a gate and go but you will go though this spot again and crew is allowed there 10-mile loop, finish

100 Mile

25-mile loop with a 10-minute gate and go crew can meet you, 45-minute hold,
15-mile loop, 45-minute hold,
25-mile loop, 50-minute hold
10-mile loop, 45-minute hold
10-mile loop, finish

Here are a few things about the hold. We will be hanging on to your vet card. You will receive a small card with info when arriving at the in/arrival timer. Please do not put the small info card in your mouth, bra, pants, I am hoping you get the idea!

When you present to the vetting area. The pulse/vetting timing tent will have your vet card ready for you and the vet. After completion of vetting the pulse timing tent will take small card and vet card to give you out time. The small card will stay with you until you drop it off at the out/departure timing tent upon departure.

I know this may sound a whole lot different than in the past. I am trying to limit how much paper changes hands.

Foxcatcher Endurance Gate and Go directions for Crew

North Appleton Parking Lot

Crewing GPS: 2941 Appleton Road, Elkton, MD

Turn left out of Base Camp from upper gate on Gallaher Road (if you leave from the lower gate on Big Elk Chapel Road, turn left out of the gate, then immediately left again at the stop sign onto Gallaher Road) Go to the end of Gallaher Road Turn right onto Route 273 Go 1 mile to the new round about and turn left onto Appleton Road Go 1.3 miles. Turn left into the Department of Natural Resources Parking Lot. The 10 Minute Gate and Go is directly in front of you. There is water available here. This stop for 50, 65, 75, 100 milers only and will be the only on trail crew spot. Crew MAY NOT drive down to the hold. Please park and walk.

Below is the zoom meeting information. My goal is a rider briefing so anyone could skip the one in person. Think social distancing. I have not run a zoom meeting before so hopefully it will all work out.

Please also after reading this note send me questions, I will do my best to answer.

The rider meeting will be 5:45 pm earlier if we finish vetting. Please remember those masks and social distancing. This will be out in the vetting jog lanes NOT in the tent.
